- It is expected that the paper is of an extended abstract type, namely: you can make a short research summary or announce some results without proof. The topic may be related to talk you have presented during the seminar, but it can be also another related topic.
- The idea is similar to publishing in journals like e.g. **C.R.A.S. Paris**, or **Doklady RAN**. Therefore, publishing a paper in this volume does not influence the publication of a full research paper, which can be published as usual elsewhere.
- The papers in the volume will be included in Scopus, MathSciNet and Zentralblatt.
- Publication is free of charge; authors should get free electronic access to the whole volume.
